RJK COMPLETES AIRBORNE SURVEY WEST SHEBANDOWAN BELT

Kirkland Lake, Ontario: RJK Explorations Ltd., is pleased to announce that it has completed and received final interpreted results to a detailed airborne magnetometer and electromagnetic survey flown over its 4,900 acre Bemar and Cloverleaf properties located in the west Shebandowan Greenstone Belt, approximately 120 kilometres west of Thunder Bay, Ontario.

The survey was conducted utilizing Geotech's helicopter borne VTEM system which was responsible for depicting Freewest Resource Canada's recent Sungold copper zinc discovery. The survey has outlined on the Bemar group of claims, numerous moderate to high conductivity priority electromagnetic anomalies some with coincident magnetic signals. All anomalies outlined by the survey lie within highly prospective stratigraphy for VMS-type (Cu, Zn) deposits consisting of mafic pillow lavas, rhyolitic tuff, breccia and agglomerates (Ontario Department of Mines, Geological Report 66, Saganangons Lake Area F.R. Harris 1968). Additionally, the geophysical results suggest a mafic complex in the southeast portion of the property that may exhibit good potential to host Kambalda type Cu-Ni deposits.

One moderate strength VTEM anomaly was outlined on the southern Cloverleaf block of claims. This area is comprised of mafic-felsic volcanics and holds good exploration potential for gold mineralization with several known gold showings within the belt.

The Company is pleased to have acquired such a favourable ground position and now combined with the recent AEM results look forward to advancing the property in a potentially emerging VMS district.
